The work for installing a 60 meter Special Steel Span between IT College and Badshahnagar is at an advanced stage while the civil work for constructing 46+85+46 meter Balance Cantilever bridge over Gomti river is also progressing fast. We are committed to complete all the civil works in time.

System works of track laying, over-head electrification, station finishing, E&M works etc. are also being done in tandem for the balance section of Lucknow Metro Phase-1A Project so that all the works are completed well in time and entire North-South corridor is made ready for commissioning as per the target stipulated by the Government.

LMRC RECIEVES 17th METRO TRAIN SET AT TRANSPORT NAGAR METRO DEPOT

On 16th July, 2018, Lucknow Metro Rail Corporation (LMRC) received the 17th Metro train set at its Transport Nagar Metro depot. The trains, which are being manufactured by Alstom Transport at their manufacturing plant in Sri City (Andhra Pradesh), are transported through special trailers by road with pilot vehicles in the front & the rear.

This set of Metro train was dispatched for Lucknow on 1st July, 2018 from Sri City. It took 16 days to transport it to the Metro Depot from Sri City while transporting it by road through special trailers. As per the contract, only three more trains are needed to be supplied to LMRC by the contractor in the coming days.

All necessary trials have been conducted at the manufacturing plant. Only dynamic trials of the train are now required to be done in the Transport Nagar Metro Depot.

LMRC UNDERTAKES "SPECIAL DRIVE" TO ENCOURAGE THE USAGE OF AUTOMATIC TOKEN VENDING MACHINE (TVM) & RECHARGE CARD TERMINAL MACHINE (RCTM) AT METRO STATIONS

Lucknow Metro Rail Corporation (LMRC) undertook a "special five day drive" between 21st June, 2018 and 25th July, 2018 at all the eight operational Metro stations between the Transport Nagar and the Charbagh of the "Priority Corridor" to encourage the usage of the automatic Token Vending Machine (TVM) and the Recharge Card Terminal Machine (RCTM) for Metro commuters.

During this period, the sale of tokens and recharge their 'GoSmart' travel cards through the automatic Recharge Card Terminal Machine (RCTM) and the automatic Token Vending Machine (TVM) installed at all Metro stations. The Metro staff and the Customer Relations Assistant (CRA) present at the RCTM/TVM at all Metro stations assisted the passengers in getting token and recharge 'GoSmart' from the machines.

It is primarily aimed at inculcating a habit among Metro commuters for using the automatic services for a smarter way so that they can save their time.
