INDIAN GREEN BUILDING COUNCIL (IGBC) CERTIFIES LMRC WITH GREEN METRO RAIL SYSTEM ONCE AGAIN; AWARDS PLATINUM CERTIFICATION TO ALL METRO STATIONS

The Indian Green Building Council (IGBC) – one of the apex body in India to rate and certify a system as a ‘Green’ system – has certified LMRC a “Green Metro Rail System” once again, thereby, awarding platinum certificate to all its Metro stations of the North-South corridor from CCS Airport to Munshipulia. With this, all 21 stations of Lucknow Metro are now platinum certified which is a highest green rating for any civil structure or building.

Platinum certificates and plaques for 13 Metro stations of the



balanced section of the North-South corridor was handed over to Shri Kumar Keshav, Managing Director, LMRC by Shri Ankit Gupta and Shri Anupam Mittal from CII-IGBC on 8th May, 2019 at the LMRC Administrative Office, Gomti Nagar. Speaking on the occasion, Shri Kumar, Managing Director said “this is an excellent achievement for LMRC and it will encourage other coming Metro in the Country to adapt green system during the construction of the project”.
